This project transformed the local road network of unsafe and misaligned intersections into an attractive gateway entrance to the University of Rochester's Medical Center. The Kendrick/Lattimore intersection was realigned and narrowed to improve sight distances and pedestrian safety. The entrance to U of R's parking lot was relocated to eliminate an unsafe, congested signalized intersection.

A unique feature of this project is the construction of an exercise trail that links the canal trail with the Genesee Valley Park trail system. The trail inclusion in the road improvement project was the result of a cooperative agreement between the City and University of Rochester.
