The final design of this award-winning project, featured in national publications such as *Civil Engineering* and winner of an ACEC Platinum Award and APWA National and New York Project of the Year, represents the epitome of efficiency, land reclamation and reuse.

Passero Associates developed a "Reuse Plan" of the 50 acre decommissioned Gates-Chili Ogden Sewage Treatment Plant Site. Our services included interviewing and programming eight (8) County Departments for their special needs intending to relocate to this site. The results were a Redevelopment Plan proposing a 90,000 square foot, Inter Agency Public Works Facility and several individual public works buildings, including records and archives storage. Passero also provided survey services over a 3-mile area to tie the site to an existing tunnel system. Passero Associates led a multi-disciplinary team of firms on this high-profile project.
