Rock Beach Road is located along a sensitive bluff, overlooking Lake Ontario. A housing development along this road includes densely built homes with narrow alleys which posed several design and construction challenges.

Passero Associates conducted the survey, design and construction inspection for the rebuilding of 4,000 LF of Rock Beach Road and installation of 4,820 LF of sanitary sewers. We used trenchless sewer rehabilitation methods including directional boring, pipe bursting and sewer lining to overcome the challenging site constraints.

Our engineering team facilitated a public participation program that included public informational meetings, flyers, newsletters and biweekly construction progress meetings.

This project was so successful that it received the American Public Works Association, Monroe County/Genesee Valley Branch's "Project of the Year" Award.
