Webster's Town Hall and police headquarters needed complete renovation. Numerous departments were rapidly expanding and their efficiency was suffering. The town hall was designed and built in the 1950s and increased technology demands and work space requirements outdated most work spaces.

Individual work spaces now meet current technology and efficiency demands and the new entrance lobby is equipped with an elevator, making the entire town hall ADA accessible.
